SENIOR MOMENTS

YOU ARE AN EXAMPLE

I often hear the words, *"I don't know why God hasn't let me go."* I suppose the answer to this question will be revealed to us when we meet our Lord face to face. Until that time, I trust that we have a purpose.

It was painful to watch my dad suffer with Multiple Myeloma. As his cancer progressed he lost desire for that which gave him joy. His discomfort was at the fore-front. Yet, as he was journeying towards death, he showed me how to rely on God, be faithful to prayer, and suffer with dignity. Dad didn't know that he was being an example to me, but he was.

We have a parishioner, who has a strong faith and close relationship to God that causes me to want the same relationship. She has such extreme trust, adoration and intimacy! It is so real, that she even gets frustrated with God and has strong conversations about her displeasure that she is still alive. She has been in a care facility for longer that she cares to be and she has seen family and friends go on to meet their maker. And she said, *"I am damn mad! When will it be my turn?!"* Yet with that question I can understand it comes from her desire to be in heaven. I do not know why she hasn't received the answer she prays for, but I do know that she is an example of faith that I want to emulate. She is an example to me.

I was at the nail salon and a young lady and I were discussing my leg and exercise. She has recently lost a significant amount of weight. She believes her exercise program has been the significant factor. She told me that some days it is difficult to motivate herself to get to the gym, but she goes. I said, *"Once you are there and seeing everyone working out, I'm sure that is motivating."* She said, *"Not everyone. I do not pay attention to the younger people. It is the elderly people who push me to go. They motivate me. I see them continuing to take care of and respecting their bodies and their health. I see people who struggle to walk, climb on an elliptical bike and pedal away. That is what motivates me! If they can have the determination so can I!"* The people who struggle at the gym are an example to her.

Who knows what actions we display without being aware? We are being examples in how we live our life and may not even be aware. *"Lord help me in my daily life that my example is helpful and pleasing to you."* Amen.

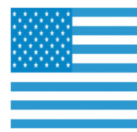
More News about eScrip Cards
